



**The Spirit of Kentucky
Fall Weekend Trip**

September 29 – October 1

Join fellow members for a fun-packed weekend in Louisville, Kentucky. The first event of the weekend will begin at noon on Friday, September 29 when we have lunch and enjoy horse racing from Millionaire's Row at Churchill Downs. There will also be an option to tour the adjacent Kentucky Derby Museum.

On Saturday, September 30, we will take a guided tour of select distilleries on the Bourbon Trail. Our stops will include Maker's Mark, Jim Beam, and Barton 1792 along with a southern style lunch in Bardstown. The trip will conclude with a group dinner Saturday evening. You can plan your departure for Sunday, October 1 or extend your stay to continue exploring Louisville or additional distilleries on the Bourbon Trail.

There is an entertainment fee of \$235 per person, excluding tax and gratuities. The cost includes Saturday night dinner (*excluding alcohol*), two lunches, Bourbon Trail tour and tastings, and a visit to Churchill Downs/Kentucky Derby Museum.
