SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

The 2021 Detroit Regional Yacht-Racing Association's Standard Sailing Instructions for Point to Point and A/B Courses are hereby adopted for this Regatta with the following modifications in the paragraphs below. All Course specific instructions are deleted.

Paragraph 1, Rules - Class Rules, where applicable will be those adopted by local fleets for DRYA participation.

STARTING SEQUENCE FOR ALL COURSES AND CLASS FLAGS

Paragraph 9 & 10, Courses & Marks - are modified to change the course location and marks as follows:

“A” & “B” COURSES & MARKS

“A” Course -Marks to Port: Starting line to GPYC W (orange mark near St. Clair Lt.), to Point Huron LT, to GPYC Y (orange mark), then to the finish line.

“A” Course -Marks to Starboard: Starting Line to Point Huron LT, to GPYC W (orange mark near St. Clair Lt.), to GPYC Y (orange mark taken to port), then to the finish line.

“B” Course -Marks to Port: Starting Line to GPYC W (orange mark near St. Clair Lt.), to GPYC X (orange mark) to GPYC Y (orange mark), then to the finish line.

“B” Course -Marks to Starboard: Starting Line to GPYC X (orange mark), to GPYC W (orange mark near St. Clair Lt.), to GPYC Y (orange mark taken to port), then to the finish line.

GPYC X mark will be approx. L.42 29.7' N. Lo 82 48.1' W.

GPYC W mark will be approx. L.42 28.2' N. Lo 82 45.4' W.

“A” & “B” START LINE -All classes will start between the yellow mark and orange flag off the GPYC East Wall located in front of the New Marine Activities Building. Signal flags will be displayed from the East Wall. *See sketch A in SIs under Chart of Course.*

Course Direction & Length-Red shape marks or red flags to port, green shape marks or green flags to starboard. Course distance calculated at: “A” Course 19.12 Nautical miles, “B” Course 12.51 Nautical miles. There will be only one race.

Finishing & Approach-A GPYC “Y” mark shall be taken to port by all classes in their final approach to the finish line. This applies to all shortened course situations as well. See sketch “B” (Finish Line Diagram) elsewhere in the Sailing Instructions. Proceed downstream to cross the **Finish Line** between the R.C. Flag on the GPYC Harbor Breakwater and the GPYC “Z” orange mark.

SHORTEN COURSE DESIGNATION

If Prior to the Start - One of the following cylindrical shapes or Code Flags is displayed from the East Wall of the Marina during the five minutes prior to the start of ANY class and the course for that class will be as noted below. A sound signal will be used to call attention to the shapes.

“A” Course - Cylindrical shape with red-white-blue vertical panels or Code Flag “T” (red-white-blue vertical stripes) - Sail “B” Course instead of “A” Course.

“B” Course - Cylindrical shape with yellow-blue-yellow horizontal bands or Code Flag “D” (yellow-blue-yellow horizontal stripes) - Sail to the first mark, thence to the GPYC “Y” Mark (orange mark) which shall be taken to port and then downstream to the Finishing Line. See sketch “B” (Finishing Line Diagram) elsewhere in Sailing Instructions.

Paragraph 16 Time Limits is modified as follows: The time limits for A & B courses shall be 6 and 4 hours, respectively.

Radio Monitoring - Yachts please monitor channel 72 VHF from one hour before the preparatory signal until after the finish.

For those boats NOT registered for the DRYA Counter Series for 2021, **you are an invited boat. The deadline for registration is Thursday, September 16, 2021 at 23:59 hours for boats requiring new ratings, and Tuesday, September 21, 2021 at 23:59 hours for boats that already have a rating.** Invited boats of GPYC members in the CLUB JAM class, as well as DRYA Counter Series boats going to CLUB JAM, are free. All other invited boats will pay a DRYA fee of \$40 to race at registration. Boats not registered will not be scored. 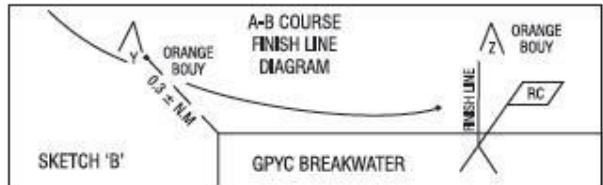
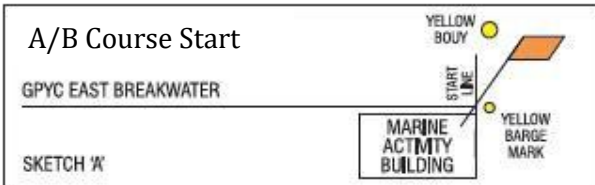
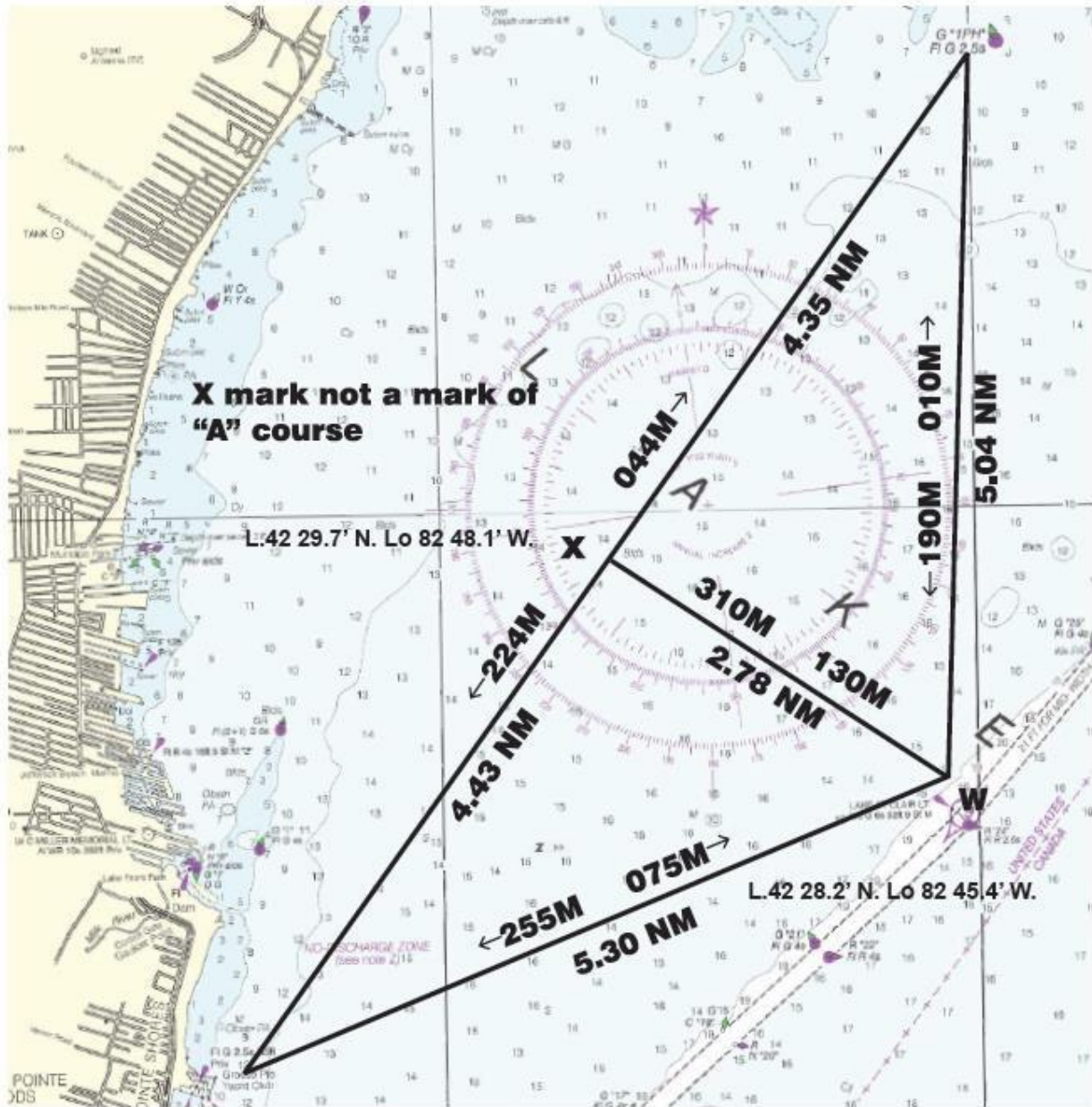
